NADSA promotes a great variety of classical concerts for all the communities living in the Newton Abbot area. The instrumentalists and singers are all national or international, used to performing at prestigious venues worldwide. There is no similar Society in Teignbridge, Exeter or Plymouth. It is unique, bringing something very special to the town.

NADSA's seven concerts each season are given at the Courtenay Centre, central to the town and with its own car park. It is located near public transport and within easy walking distance of the nearby public car park. The Sunday afternoon concerts, held during the winter months, are particularly popular. Although NADSA is a membership Society, about 60% of our audience are not members. Each performance attracts a very different audience. During the season, the instrumentalists give workshops to interested schools in Newton Abbot. In this way, the town's children meet classical music and its role-model performers. They have fun and take with them life-long memories.
