
# How will you publicise the Newton Abbot Town Council grant?

NEWTON ABBOT COMMUNITY SHED.

I hope your drive was uneventful, and that you have a smooth flight tomorrow.

Here's my estimate of the costs of making the items we discussed:

#### Seed sieves x4: Materials £60

These would be approximately 300mm square or A4 (210 x 300mm), depending on the availability of mesh panels. These are proving quite tricky to source and, depending on the mesh size, are likely to be a mix of stainless and galvanised steel, with the possibility of one or more in untreated mild steel (which of course can rust). The only supplier I can find for the 2.5mm mesh is out of stock, and I'm waiting to hear if and when they'll be getting any more.

Based on the prices I've found, the four trays, each with a catch tray containing the fabric bag and shutter, will cost approximately £60 (so £15 each) in materials. I haven't included a cost for the wood, because I think we can use pallet timber which would be free – and that would be somehow fitting for this kind of item.

#### Seed cleaner: Materials £40

The main cost in this is the plastic front panel. We may be able to source a big enough piece of scrap (which will be in decent condition), but for the purpose of this costing I have assumed we will need to buy it. The wooden structure we can, again, make from reclaimed pallet timber, with the back panel made from plywood that our good friend at Brunel Supplies will give us FoC.


